**Footnotes**

NO RYTHUM devoid of early foot, split rivals around the turn, rallied mid track and was up in the final stride. AVOLA off last, advanced from the rail before the turn, was angled out five wide to rally, gained the lead late and just missed. OTE' LE CHAPEAU lacked speed, found her best stride late and was late inside the top two. BAG WOMAN vied between rivals early, gained the edge before the drive, shook free and faltered late. WHOA BABY WHOA prominent while four wide, offered her best a quarter out and weakened. MAGIC NURSE unhurried while out sprinted, made a run five wide and faded. WINTER DANCE vied for the lead until nearing mid stretch and gave way. IRISH SISTER close up from the rail, steadied slightly entering the turn and then faded. TRICK ER TREAT trailed and improved position. I'M A TUDOR stumbled at the start and was outrun. SHELOVESTOBOOGIE was outrun. SIX PAC AIMEE flashed speed and stopped badly.
