BIND settled in third position, moved closer while four wide on the turn, was asked a bit at the top of the stretch, took over near the three-sixteenths pole and drew away while ridden out in an impressive debut. TALE OF THE DANCE broke a bit slow, was urged some while off the pace, raced between rivals on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and earned the place while no match for the winner. SARACEN bumped with LEESTOWNS FINALE after the start, moved to the lead, set the pace through blistering fractions, raced off the rail on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and tired while able to save the show. RED ACE dropped back while urged along, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. SAUCY STASH chased the fast pace, raced three wide on the turn and weakened. RYS ALLEY CAT lunged at the start and broke about three lengths slow, raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. QUARRY OF GOLD settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and failed to respond. RACK DADDY bumped with HIT THE ROAD LEE after the start, settled on the outside, raced three then four wide on the turn and retreated.
