STAKES Colonel Power S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No Nomination Fee; \$300 to enter; \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf since December 19th, allowed 2 lbs. \$30,000 on the turf since then 4 lbs. \$25,000 on the turf since November 19th, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. NOTE: This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. High Weights will be preferred.

Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, February 5, 2011, with 20 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.) (Rail at 10 feet).

### Footnotes

DUE DATE settled on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, was asked while four wide into the stretch, rallied on the far outside, closed strongly alongside STRIKE IMPACT, battled with that rival late and gamely prevailed under strong urging. STRIKE IMPACT bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, was well placed just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, was given his cue coming to the quarter-pole, moved out under left hand urging in upper stretch, closed strongly alongside DUE DATE, battled gamely with that rival late and just missed in a good effort. SWEETSOUTHERNMOON settled towards the rear of the field, raced inside on the turn, moved out in the final furlong and finished with good late energy to get the show. SOUTHERN REGION bumped with STRIKE IMPACT at the start, was rated on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, took the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, led into the final sixteenth but was outfinished then caught for the show at the wire. DELANO settled on the inside, was urged along while near the rail on the turn, moved out some in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. ROYAL EXPRESS set the clear pace, vied inside on the turn, was set down in upper stretch, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong and gave way. DON'T SHOOT bumped with a rival at the start, tracked the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. (Rail at 10 Feet)
