Footnotes

EXPANSION raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved in the front half of the field, went two then three wide on the far turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, made a bid in upper stretch, dueled in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. SLEEPLESS KNIGHT raced off the rail on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased into the final furlong, didn't have enough room for a rail rally, altered course to the outside approaching the sixteenth-pole and closed determinedly to just miss. DUBIOUS MISS bumped with a rival at the start, moved out passing the wire the first time, raced four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, turned up the pressure on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, dueled in the final furlong and just missed in a three-way photo. WORKIN FOR HOPS inherited the lead when absolutely nobody wanted to take the advantage, raced three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace through sluggish fractions, vied inside on the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and gave way grudgingly. JOINEM raced four wide on the first turn, was reserved near the back, went two to three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and finished willingly on the outside. GRAN ESTRENO (ARG) bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. LOUP BRETON (IRE) was reserved on the inside of GRAN ESTRENO, came under the whip in upper stretch, moved in nearing the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. SKIP A SMILE raced four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside then settled, went three then four wide on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. TELLING was bumped on both sides at the start, lagged at the rear of the field while off the rail and failed to threaten. (Rail at 10 Feet)
