TEMP brushed with a rival after the start, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, gained a short lead passing the eighth-pole, drifted out in the final furlong and prevailed under strong urging. HARD CASE set the pace under pressure, was asked for his best in upper stretch, lost the lead entering the final furlong and was outfinished while clear for the place. CONTEMPORARY bumped lightly with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and was best of the rest. ALACO CASTLE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, pressed the pace, vied two to three wide on the turn and tired. DR BALLENGER broke in at the start, settled on the outside while under some urging, raced two to three wide on the turn and failed to respond. EDDIE'S BAND broke a bit slow then dropped back, moved out at the rear of the field, went five wide on the turn, floated seven wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. EVEN settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn and came up empty.
