Footnotes

THE REVEREND JAMES was completely void of speed, raced at the rear of the field, went two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, moved further out once straightened for the drive, rallied in the center of the track and closed with a rush to get up at the wire. SLIGHTLY USED was ridden along towards the front, raced four then three wide on the turn, drifted in inside the quarter-pole, was straightened by the rider, closed well to get the lead late but was denied at the wire. WHO DAT MAX was reluctant to load, dueled on the outside, edged clear early on the turn, maintained a clear advantage into the final furlong but was overtaken late while able to hold the show. COOPER JAMES lacked early speed, raced well back in the field, swung six wide into the stretch and finished well. HOT FOOT HEAT was a bit reluctant to load then urged along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, moved to five wide outside the quarter-pole, drifted in outside the furlong marker and finished willingly but lacked the needed kick. BANDIT'S BULLET moved in while well back in the field, saved ground on the turn, was guided out in upper stretch and improved position. EXPRESSIANO was ridden along in

the front half of the field, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. CAJUN STREAKER was ridden along towards the front, raced off the rail on the turn and had nothing left. STORM OSIDY was hustled from the start then urged along on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. GOODIFITGOES was ridden along while off the pace, moved out on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. RON JOVI chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, steadied near the five-sixteenths pole, moved to four wide shortly thereafter and faded. SALTWATER BOY was hustled from the start, dueled on the inside and stopped.
