Footnotes

SHELTERED raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved in the second flight, went three to four wide on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead inside the furlong marker then moved clear under strong handling. PAPER SHREDDER stumbled at the start but recovered quickly, moved up to take the lead, raced four wide on the first turn, set the pace on an open lead, went three wide on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, drifted out a bit near the furlong marker and was overtaken while able to hold the place. P. S. I LOVE YOU was reserved in the back half of the field, raced four to five wide on the far turn and finished willingly for the show. MONA LISA (GER) raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced off the rail early on the far turn then dropped to the inside, gained ground in upper stretch but lacked the needed response. CHICALELEE bobbled at the start, raced inside on the first turn, settled well off the pace and failed to threaten. HOOKED ON HOPE raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved in a bit near the seven-sixteenths pole, went three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the

stretch and failed to rally. MAYMEISTER was caught five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. TURBO JUSTICE raced three then two wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. WOODY'S BLUFF raced off the rail on the first turn, settled in the second flight, was urged some while two to three wide on the far turn and had nothing left. EMBERS GLOWING lagged at the rear of the field and showed little. (Rail at 10 Feet)
