Footnotes

GIANT'S TOMB was well placed while off the rail, bided his time on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, rallied into the final furlong and closed determinedly to get up late. GRIZZLED ROBERT raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, was put to a drive shortly thereafter, rallied into the final furlong, closed well alongside the winner and just missed. MOUNTAIN JUSTICE settled off the pace, was roused while four then five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly but missed. FIST OF RAGE raced four wide on the first turn, prompted the leader on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn, floated four wide into the stretch, drifted in near the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear shortly thereafter, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken. TIGHT GRIP was well placed on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, steadied a bit near the three-sixteenths pole, altered course to the outside and weakened. CABERNEIGH raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. KING MESA raced three wide on the first turn, set the pace through tepid fractions, lost the lead at the top of the stretch, steadied a bit when FIST OF RAGE drifted in then gave way. CROSS VILLAGE broke a bit slow, raced three wide on the first turn, lingered near the back, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. Following a rider's claim of foul and stewards' inquiry into the stretch run, no change was made to the order of finish. (Rail at 10 Feet)
