Footnotes

GOLDEN GLEN unhurried, moved out a bit around the second turn, circled foes while rallying for the drive, bid outside A SPOT OF GREATNES nearing the furlong marker, gained the edge and proved clearly best. A SPOT OF GREATNES close up while off the rail, bid three wide entering the second turn, loomed outside FRONTIER GROOM approaching the final furlong and then while no match for the winner lasted for second. GRAB SOME GRASS forward along the inside, switched out late and finished well. PAINT BALLADO reserved until approaching the second turn, circled foes and lacked the needed finish. FRONTIER GROOM sprinted clear early, set the pace until nearing mid stretch, got overtaken and weakened. RIO RUCKUS showed little. HOMEBUYER was outrun. DENNY'S VICTORY forward for six furlongs, gave way. HARVARD YARD dropped back. BLUE MINGO was always back.
