MISTER MARTI GRAS four wide around the first turn, settled off the rail to the second turn, angled in when rallying for the drive, finished big along the rail and proved best. TIMELY PURSUIT never far back, rallied mid track and was too late. COGNASHENE inside to the drive, angled out and got up for the show. WHERE U AT forwardly placed, bid around the second turn, then had no final kick. BASCOM HALL set the pace off the rail, was overtaken inside the final furlong and then weakened late. STERN devoid speed, showed late interest. THE TAP trailed to the drive, then passed beaten foes. THEY CALL HIM EL forwardly placed, loomed nearing the drive, then failed to sustain his bid. SICOMORO was outrun. SPEEDY MON was never dangerous. SUNSET RIDER vied for the lead for a half, then gave way. SAINTLY TALE dropped back.
