FARCE IDE settled nicely off the pace while off the inside, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, was guided out inside the quarter-pole then bobbled, rallied on the outside, closed well while lugging in ever so slightly, grabbed the lead late then prevailed while eased up in the final strides. BRILLANT AND ROYAL was restless in the gate, brushed with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed well to loom a threat into the final sixteenth but missed while able to get the place. SHIMMERING PORT broke through the front of the gate prior to the start, raced three then two wide on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, controlled the action while off the rail on the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while clear for the show. NEW ELITE broke a bit slow, settled towards the rear, was urged along while inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and improved position. CALLEY'S ROCKET brushed with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, was put to an all out drive in upper stretch and weakened. MISS SWEET DREAMS settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, chased between horses on the far turn and gave way. RED MOON CAT broke through the gate prior to the start, raced three wide on

the first turn, settled towards the back of the field, was urged some while three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. TRIBUTE'S PASSION was a bit rank while rated on the inside, settled a bit on the backstretch, chased inside on the far turn and came up empty. SISTER ANTHONY raced four to five wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, went four wide on the far turn and had nothing left. BEAUVOIR broke a step slow, lagged at the rear and showed little. (Rail at 10 Feet)
