CELADON settled on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead passing the eighth-pole, battled gamely in the final furlong and prevailed under strong urging. SPEEDY SPICE settled off the pace in the tightly bunched field, raced three to four wide while between rivals on the turn, bobbed while behind horses inside the quarter-pole, moved out and found clear running inside the furlong marker then closed well but was too late. HELLO MONDAY set the pace through slow fractions, vied two to three wide on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, battled determinedly in the stretch but was outfinished late while able to get the show. WATER OF LIFE was well placed just off the pace, raced two to three wide while between rivals on the turn, came under some urging in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong, steadied while blocked near the sixteenth-pole and lost her best chance. DAJOHNA tracked the leader on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for her best in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth then weakened late. VERA BELLE settled at the rear of the field, raced inside on the turn, was roused in upper stretch and reached her best stride too late. TRUE BREW settled just off the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. (Rail at 10 Feet)
