POLITE AND COZY settled on the inside, moved closer midway down the backstretch, bided her time while inside on the far turn, moved out behind rivals in upper stretch then was roused, rallied on the outside, gained ground into the final sixteenth, drifted out late and got up near the wire. LIVEALITTLEBIT settled on the outside, moved closer midway down the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, made a bid passing the furlong marker, drifted out some shortly thereafter, was switched to a right-handed whip, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. LEE'S ZEAL tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid leaving the backstretch, was put to a drive in upper stretch, vied into the final furlong and weakened while well clear for the show. CLASSIC MOCCASIN hit the inside of the gate at the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the back, was roused while off the rail on the far turn and failed to respond. ROSY DAY set the pace on the inside through moderate fractions, was challenged leaving the backstretch, came under a drive in upper stretch, dropped back entering the final furlong and gave way. SIZZLIN LIZZIE was restless in the gate then lunged at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was ridden along while four wide on the far turn and came up empty.
