### Footnotes

ANSWER THE OFFICER was rated off the pace while off the inside, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide into the stretch, was put to a drive, gained ground on the outside, took the lead near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under measured handling. GUILLE went five then four wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, bumped with TRESS near the sixteenth-pole and just missed. TRESS was well rated while setting the pace off the rail, responded well when set down at the top of the stretch, drifted out a bit and bumped with GUILLE near the sixteenth-pole then was outfinished while able to get the show. SILENT SISTER went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went four wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came six wide into the stretch and finished willingly but missed the show. BROOKE'S JOURNEY went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. SECRET INFORMATION raced five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, settled at the rear, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, angled out near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. CUT THE DECK settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and came up empty. FAWNING settled towards the rear, raced off the rail on the turns and failed to respond.
