### Footnotes

MANCHAC came out at the start, was reserved off the pace, moved closer midway down the backstretch, waited behind rivals on the far turn, shifted three wide outside quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead outside the furlong marker and edged clear under good handling. THUNDER AFFAIR raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved up midway down the backstretch, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, lost touch with the winner nearing the furlong marker and was second best. PINECREST PIRATE raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer midway down the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, drifted inward in upper stretch and weakened while clear for the show. COUPEE raced two to three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader on the far turn, vied into the stretch and came up empty. MY FRIEND ROY TOO lagged at the rear of the field, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. WINEANSTORM set the pace on the inside, was challenged on the far turn, dropped out near the quarter-pole and faded. SIR NAT settled off the pace while on the inside, saved ground on both turns and retreated. SOMPINTOTALKABOUT walked out of the gate and unseated the rider.
