Footnotes

DECEPTIVE VISION went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid outside the quarter-pole, dropped behind IRISH LUTE while under a drive in upper stretch, chased that rival into the final furlong, came back on the outside late and prevailed under strong urging. IRISH LUTE was taken in hand while along the rail, tracked the leader on the inside, moved through to take the advantage outside the three-eighths pole, briefly moved clear, was challenged outside the quarter-pole, shook clear again under a drive in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. KIPLING'S JOY was last away, settled on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, rallied on the far turn, came off the rail while making a bid outside the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch and was outfinished while clear for the show. PROPELLERONEWAY lagged at the rear of the field, angled five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, continued five wide into the stretch and improved position. ASSETS OF WAR went three to four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, raced three wide on the far turn, waited behind rivals from the three-eighths pole to the five-sixteenths pole, came between horses outside the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. SWEET CITIZEN went three wide on the first turn, settled in the front half, was ridden along on the far turn and faded. EASY TAP settled well off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and failed to respond. BELLINIZIA broke out at the start, went five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, dropped back while four wide on the far turn and retreated. TRULY MAJESTIC set the pace through quick fractions, lost the lead early on the turn, was taken up while dropping back near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped.
