DESCAPATE three wide around the first turn, continued three wide while stalking the leaders, ranged up approaching the drive, took over and drew away. MIMI'S TIZZY crossed to the rail while out sprinted, advanced nearing the second turn, split foes around the second turn, bid three wide for the drive and while no match for the winner was game for second. GAL ON THE GO well back early, found her best stride midway around the second turn, circled foes four wide for the drive and got up for third. MALTESE SUPERB set the pace until nearing the drive, was headed and faltered inside the final furlong. INSTINCT saved ground, eased out around the second turn and then could make little impact. SCOOP unhurried, saved ground around the second turn and then had no final kick. MOMENTOUS close up along the rail, tired. OUR MAJESTIC CAT dropped back. CELLO saved ground until approaching the second turn, moved outside and faded. CAT AND THE HAT restrained while racing off the rail, retreated.
