GROUND TRANSPORT went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong, gained the lead approaching the sixteenth-pole then drew clear under steady handling. FREE WORLD bumped lightly with CARSON'S CROWN at the start, stalked the pace on the outside while under a snug hold, turned up the pressure on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, inched clear under a drive, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and proved no match for the winner late while clear for the place. CARSON'S CROWN bumped lightly with FREE WORLD at the start, went three then two wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while inside on the far turn and failed to rally while best of the rest. WINNING NOTE set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead after turning into the stretch and gave way. HAWAAKOM was restrained while chomping at the bit on the first turn, raced at the rear, was asked with three furlongs to run, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. WHISKEY BRAVO was a bit reluctant to load, broke out at the start, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced off the rail early on the far turn then shifted four wide, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor.
