### Footnotes

HIP FOUR SIXTYNINE bumped lightly with PASS THE PICO at the start, settled while under some urging, went two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed fast to get the lead just inside the furlong marker then drew clear under strong urging. RUN WITH HONOR was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, came through along the rail to take the lead at the top of the stretch, inched clear under a drive, lost the advantage inside the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. HALL'S VILLAGE was urged along while off the pace, hesitated behind TELLING WAYS nearing the five-sixteenths pole, moved out in upper stretch and just got up for the show. TOOLPUSHER showed good speed, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn, pursued RUN WITH HONOR into the final furlong and tired. PASS THE PICO bumped lightly with HIP FOUR SIXTYNINE at the start, was urged along on the outside, went three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and failed to rally. STRONG HUMOR showed good speed, set the pace while off the rail, lost the lead at the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch and gave way. COLUMN settled at the rear while on the inside, waited while stuck at the back on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. CRUISE DIRECTOR was asked from the start, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. TELLING WAYS was coaxed along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond.
