### Footnotes

MARK VALESKI brushed with GOLDEN TICKET passing the seven-eighths pole, was rated under a tight hold while just behind the pacesetter, came under an even stronger hold while eager approaching the half-mile pole, waited while boxed in on the far turn, was blocked behind the leading trio into upper stretch, altered course to the outside passing the three-sixteenths pole, quickly accelerated when finally clear, rallied to the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. COOL STREET lagged at the rear of the field while off the rail, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch, angled out under a drive outside the three-sixteenths pole, rallied on the outside and closed fast to get the place. GOLDEN TICKET brushed with MARK VALESKI passing the seven-eighths pole, went three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace while on the outside, inched closer while three wide on the far turn, was asked outside the three-sixteenths pole, gained a short lead, lost the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished then just missed the place. HERO OF ORDER raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace through tepid fractions, vied inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, battled into the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. INFRATTINI went three then two wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, drew even on the far turn, was asked after turning into the stretch, battled between horses into the final furlong and weakened. MACHO BULL went three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace on the outside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, gained ground into the stretch, chased on the outside and lacked the needed kick. RAISON D'ETAT was taken in hand early, saved ground on the first turn, was unhurried near the back, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was roused while inside on the far turn and failed to rally.
