VIRGINIA FLAPPER unhurried while outrun, bid three wide nearing the drive, gained the lead approaching mid stretch and out kicked DIADELLA to the wire. DIADELLA four wide early, advanced between rivals around the second turn, came four wide in upper stretch and could not get past the winner. DANCE MEMORIES trailed early, rallied five wide around the second turn, offered her best a furlong out and could make little impact. TAKE OUT THE SILKS never far back, had no rally. WORLD STORM unhurried early, improved position. GRANDPA'S GRAY settled early and then passed tiring foes. PANTELLERIA was outrun. SINGER set a pressured pace and faltered turning for home. NURSE LAURA saved ground. CHASE SUNNY BROAD forward early, bid along the rail and faded. FRONT ROW SEAT prompted the pace for six furlongs, stopped. TANTALIZE close up for a half, stopped.
