SARAGUSKA exchanged brushes with FLATTERING REPORT at the break, was hustled clear entering the first turn, then remained clear throughout. TRACK RECORD bobbed at the break, trailed to before the second turn, came five wide around the second turn and was getting to the winner. INVISIBLE FORCE unhurried early, came three wide around the second turn and made a late gain. OCEAN SPRINGS SLEW forwardly placed off the rail, made a run at SARAGUSKA around the second turn and then had no final kick. GREAT SHOT unhurried, was no real threat. KING CADEN inside to the second turn, was steered widest to rally and then could make little impact. CHOCOLATE CREAM forwardly placed to nearing the second turn, dropped back. FLATTERING REPORT exchanged brushes with SARAGUSKA at the break, raced inside early and then retreated. JETT CITY raced wide.
