HIGH TONED parked four wide while close up, came three wide around the turn, ranged up outside KAT'S COURT nearing mid stretch but was no match late. PEACHIE KING moved in early, was unhurried while continuing inside around the turn, moved out for the drive, drifted in while rallying and got up for the show. SON OF A BRIDE inside to the drive, eased out after turning for home and then had no response. ISABELLA SYMPHONEY was outrun. BOLD LOUISA'S BOY raced wide. BAD BOY AIDAN set the pace off the rail, got headed before mid stretch and then faltered.
