### Footnotes

TRIBUTE TO LIBERTY was sent hard from the start, chased the pace, took the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole, quickly moved clear and drew off under strong urging. MASTER WAGON raced well back in the field, went three then four wide on the turn and got up for the place. MAJOR RYAN O'QUINN chased the pace through the turn and proved no match for the winner then was caught for the place. MARDISGRAS TOY was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and weakened. COHEN'S BANDITO was ridden along on the inside, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. MATIAS was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide early on the turn, shifted five wide near the three-eighths pole, continued five wide into the stretch and was no factor. J P LIMIT lacked early speed, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped to the inside in upper stretch and also was no factor. MR. ANDREW was ridden along while off the pace and also failed to threaten. PRINCE DAY was void of speed, dropped to the inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and showed little. GIACOMO VINCENZO was ridden along in the back half of the field, went two then three wide on the turn and was outrun. PALMER TOUR was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. MY DADDY HEIR set the pace, lost the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole and stopped then was eased but walked off.
