K D'S KING KONG was in tight at the start, settled just off the pace while off the inside, came under some urging on the far turn, moved out once straightened for the drive, rallied under the whip, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong urging. BIGBANDIT bumped lightly with a rival at the start, settled well back in the field, was urged along on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, loomed a threat into the final furlong but was second best. GROVE CITY STORM set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and weakened while able to get the show. BRANDONSBABYBLAYRE saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was roused on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, angled in soon thereafter and failed to rally. WHO DAT FANS raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased four wide on the far turn and tired. DAPPLE DOWN raced three wide on the first turn, had the saddle slip early on the backstretch, moved up to contest the pace, continued with the rider unable to have full control, vied three to four wide on the far turn and gave way in an unlucky journey. GAUGUINS KINGDOM bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn and was no factor. C. MCHALE was rated on the inside while a bit eager, came up empty on the far turn and faded.
