SUNDAY MISSILE dueled on the outside, moved clear midway through the turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the eighth-pole, battled gamely in the final furlong, brushed with ZEN TO WIN late and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. ZEN TO WIN was urged along on the outside, chased three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, dueled with SUNDAY MISSILE in the final furlong, brushed with that rival late and was denied. BADJO BADJO BADJO settled off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. CONTEMPORARY ART settled while under some urging, raced two to three wide on the turn and failed to rally. KELA'S HEAT dropped back while ridden along, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. VALID WILL was urged along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and was no factor. VLADKAZ lacked early speed, raced four wide into the turn then dropped in and never reached contention. GOT MELLO was in tight early then dropped back, raced five wide into the turn then dropped to three wide and also never reached contention. TETON'S GLORY chased the pace, raced inside on the turn and faded then was vanned off after the race. ONE RANGER dueled on the inside of the winner, dropped out midway through the turn and stopped.
