TRIUMPH AND SONG set the clear pace, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held under strong urging. MAKE A FORTUNE settled on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. PERREGAUX settled off the pace, raced near the inside on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. RADIANT TALENT settled just off the pace while on the outside, chased three then four wide on the turn, pursued the winner into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. PISGAH STATION settled towards the back, went two to three wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. GOODTIMEHADBYALL settled near the back, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail and failed to threaten. INDISPUTABLE was coaxed along in second, chased two to three wide on the turn and tired. CHILLED settled at the rear, was urged along while four wide on the turn and was no factor.
