DYNAMIC TIME showed good speed then chased the pace, raced four then three wide on the turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, made a bid near the eighth-pole, battled with ROLL ME AWAY in the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. ROLL ME AWAY moved up to take the lead, set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, was asked for his best while a bit off the inside in upper stretch, led into the final furlong, came in a bit near the sixteenth-pole, had BELEND clip his heels and was outfinished while able to get the place. KAT'S COURT broke alertly then dropped back on the outside, moved in while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out under urging in upper stretch, steadied slightly when RYNO'S HOMERUN drifted out coming to the furlong marker then finished willingly for the show. SALTY SID settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly on the outside. AIR COMBAT settled towards the rear, raced inside early on the turn then moved off the rail, shifted out some in upper stretch, waited while blocked from the eighth-pole to the sixteenth-pole and lost any chance. RYNO'S HOMERUN showed good speed then pressed on the outside, vied three then two wide on the turn, drifted out a bit while dropping back near the furlong marker, was taken up to avoid the spill near the sixteenth-pole and gave way. STAR PRODUCTION settled on the outside, chased five then four wide on the turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch and tired. BELEND settled off the pace, drafted behind rivals while near the inside on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, raced behind the leader while under urging in upper stretch, lacked room inside that rival in the vicinity of the furlong marker, was taken up near the sixteenth-pole then clipped heels with ROLL ME AWAY and fell. Following a stewards' inquiry, ROLL ME AWAY was disqualified from second and placed last for interference near the sixteenth-pole.
