SWITCHING GEARS raced three to four wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside while in hand, vied three wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, dueled with ST. JOHN'S RIVER in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. ST. JOHN'S RIVER raced four then three wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, went three then four wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, made a bid near the eighth-pole, dueled gamely with SWITCHING GEARS in the final furlong and was denied. SUAVE VOIR FAIRE raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, drafted behind rivals while off the rail on the far turn, was roused in upper stretch, moved in near the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. WAHOO BABE bumped with a rival at the start, was rated just off the pace while off the inside, moved up between rivals midway down the backstretch, disputed the pace, vied off the rail on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened. HARBOR FOX raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. THE REAL MAYO raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to menace. MISS POLLY bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace while in hand, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, waited behind the leader near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked at the top of the stretch and came up empty.
