FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, February 11th; \$400 to enter; \$400 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf since November 25th, allowed 2 lbs. \$30,000 on the turf since October 25th, allowed 4 lbs. \$25,000 on the turf since then allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference will be given to horses with the highest total earnings on the turf in 2011-2012. Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, February 11, 2012, with 24 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.) (Rail at 7 feet).

Footnotes

COUNTRY DAY chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, took the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, drifted out while in front and gamely prevailed under strong urging. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE chased the pace off the rail then between rivals, swung five wide at the top of the stretch, moved out while under a drive, pursued the winner determinedly in the final furlong and missed while just up for the place. CACTUS SON was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, battled determinedly towards the inside and just missed the place. HEIR JOE was urged along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, moved out some in the stretch and finished with good energy. LONESOME STREET settled while under some urging, shifted four wide near the three-eighths pole, moved to five wide around the five-sixteenths pole, swung six wide into the stretch and also finished with good energy. SWEETSOUTHERNMOON lacked early speed at the rear, swung six wide into the stretch and finished with good late energy. SOUTHERN STYLE settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. JOE HOLLYWOOD pressed the pace on the outside, chased the winner into the final furlong and tired. ZEB set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. UNO DUCKSY settled on the

outside, raced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SMOKETHRUKEYHOLE broke out a bit at the start, was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. (Rail at 7 Feet)
