Footnotes

NEHRO dropped back between rivals early, settled while off the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, shifted four wide midway through the far turn, was asked for run, rallied to the lead inside the quarter-pole and drew off under a strong hand ride. MAJESTIC HARBOR brushed with a rival at the start, set the pace while a bit off the rail, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the lead shortly thereafter and proved no match while clear for the place. ADIRONDACK EXPRESS brushed with a rival at the start, was reserved on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, raced inside on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came off the rail, was put to a drive in upper stretch and came up empty while best of the rest. ONLY BOY went four wide on the first turn, settled at the rear, raced three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the three-eighths pole, advanced on the outside but also came up empty. BIG TOWN raced three wide on the first turn, settled near the back, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, dropped to the inside near the quarter-pole and had nothing left. STINKING CREEK broke a bit awkwardly, raced three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and stopped.
