FOR THREE YEAR OLD FILLIES, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. No Nomination Fee. \$300 to pass the entry box, \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2010-2011, allowed 2 lbs.; Two races at a mile or over on the turf other than maiden or claiming, allowed 4 lbs.; One such race, allowed 6 lbs. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest career earnings. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. **THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY.** Closed Saturday, February 12, 2011, with 19 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and 70 Yards.) (Rail at 25 feet). (S)

Footnotes

LOVENOTLOST was very rank while hard held early, steadied off heels entering the first turn, raced four wide early on that turn then dropped to the inside, continued a bit rank while under restraint early on the backstretch, was reserved off the pace, came under some urging while three wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, made a bid inside the eighth-pole, battled gamely with TENSAS PUNCH in the final furlong, drifted out a bit late and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. TENSAS PUNCH was restless in the gate then stumbled at the start, was a bit rank while under restraint early, raced two to three wide on the first turn, moved up while under a tight hold, made a bid at the top of the stretch, was set down shortly thereafter, battled gamely with LOVENOTLOST in the final furlong, drifted out a bit late and just missed. TAKE ME HOME TOO set the pace through sluggish fractions while on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under the whip shortly thereafter, battled determinedly in the final furlong but was outfinished while able to get the show. DO DAT BLUES was rated just off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, moved out and was asked near the quarter-pole, chased through upper stretch, hesitated while just behind the leader passing the furlong marker, was put to a right-handed whip shortly thereafter and lacked the needed kick. CAT'S PRODUCTION raced inside on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, bided her time while off the rail on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly. SWEETTALKIN HOTTIE was restless in the gate then taken back after the start, angled in at the rear of the field, was reserved near the back, came under urging on the far turn and failed to rally. AVERY ROSE was restless in the gate then forced five wide entering the first turn, dropped to one off the rail by mid-turn, lingered near the back of the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. SWEET RUSTON was very rank while hard held early, swerved four wide entering the first turn, continued four wide while still rank on that turn, was rated on the outside, went four wide while given her head on the far turn and faltered. (Rail at 25 Feet)
