Weights: Thursday, February 17th. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. High Weights on the scale will be preferred. Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Failure to draw into the race cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, February 12, 2011, with 28 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and 1/16.) **Footnotes**

UPPERLINE bumped with FOREST UPROAR in the early going, shifted out leaving the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, chased four on the far turn, gained the lead at the top of the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, drew clear into the final furlong, drifted out outside the sixteenth-pole and held well under continued right hand urging. CATEGORY SEVEN raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, was tipped out five wide near the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch, closed determinedly on the outside but failed to reach the winner while able to get the place. FOREST UPROAR bumped with UPPERLINE in the early going, raced three wide on the first turn, moved out entering the backstretch, settled in third position, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, lugged in while under left hand urging and finished willingly but lacked the needed kick late. ICE MIST took the early lead, went three wide on the first turn, set the pace while well out in the course, vied three wide on the far turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and weakened. SINGLE SOLUTION raced between rivals on the first turn, was reserved near the back, went three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. INSTANT STYLE was taken back after the start then reserved on the inside, came under some urging while continuing to save ground on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and also failed to rally. EXQUISITE (NZ) was taken in hand early, raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging on the far turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 25 Feet)
