TORO BRAVO set the pace under pressure, drifted well out in the course, vied four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and held under strong urging. SU CASA G CASA chased the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch, chased while under a drive and finished willingly but missed. ROYAL PRODUCTION pressed the pace on the outside, vied five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch, battled under a drive and was outfinished while just able to get the show. CHIEF JAY lacked early speed, raced three to four wide early on the turn, moved to five or six wide late on the turn, swung eight wide into the stretch and finished with good energy while outside the center of the course. MY STAR RUNNER settled while under some urging, lugged out while four wide early on the turn, continued four wide, dropped to three wide at the top of the stretch and finished willingly. COME ON LENARD chased the pace, raced six wide on the turn, came seven wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. ST. ARIAN was ridden along on the outside, raced seven then six wide on the turn, dropped to four wide nearing the quarter-pole and failed to rally. HIT THE ROAD LEE was urged along while off the pace, raced five wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and also failed to rally. (Rail at 7 Feet)
