TRAVEL ADVISORY went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, rallied four then five wide on the far turn, surged to the front in upper stretch, drew clear into the final furlong and maintained a safe advantage under strong urging. ALL STORMY was taken back early, raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, shifted six wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and finished with good energy to secure the place. ATLANTIC TITAN raced four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and earned the show while no match for the top two. ALEXANDER THEGREAT settled off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and improved position. QUIET ACCELERATION settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and failed to rally. MABROOM raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, inched clear on the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. WHO DAT

AMBUSH settled in the back half of the field, saved ground on the turns and failed to threaten. REAL POWER raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. CHITCHATATTHETRACK raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn and came up empty. CONTROL TOWER contested the pace, dropped back late on the backstretch, chased inside on the far turn and tired. INDIAN SUOVENIR raced four wide on the first turn, prompted the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and capitulated. (Rail at 7 Feet)
