MAJOR PRINCE was well rated while on the inside, responded well when asked in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong and held while drifting out some under strong urging. NOWHERE TO HIDE raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, ranged up while three then four wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and gained gradually but missed. VIGILANTE LAW was reserved off the pace, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, was roused while behind rivals in upper stretch, steadied while blocked from the eighth-pole to the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the show but lost any chance at the win. ADULARE tracked the pace, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased into the final furlong and weakened. SUMO raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and tired. STREET TALK'N MAN was well placed on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and gave way. FACE THE FIRE raced four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. KENNESSEY raced three wide on the first turn and was no factor.
