LU RAVI allowed to settle, advanced nearing the final turn, awaited room around the turn, eased out four wide to rally approaching the drive, gained the edge outside SHASHOBEGON a furlong out and drew off. SHASHOBEGON stalked the leaders three wide, loomed boldly around the final turn, took over before the drive and while no match for the winner bested the rest of the field. SILENT ESKIMO between rivals early, went after UANME to contest the pace, put a head in front a quarter out and was game for third. SEOUL three wide early, found her best stride midway around the final turn, swung out six wide and lacked a late kick. UANME sprinted clear and to the rail, responded when collared and faded once displaced. HOLY NOLA broke alertly, settled down the backstretch, came five wide for the drive and flattened out. PANTUFLA bobbled and veered out at the break, failed to menace.
