ZEB contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, inched clear at the top of the stretch, was asked for his best near the three-sixteenths pole, maintained a clear lead while racing greenly in the stretch and proved best under strong urging. FOREST RUN pressed the pace between rivals, vied inside on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, bobbled outside the three-sixteenths pole, chased the winner into the final furlong and was outfinished while just able to get the place. WINTER CANYON settled on the inside, moved out leaving the backstretch, raced two then three wide on the turn, shifted out and was roused in upper stretch and finished willingly but missed the place. LA PIANO MAN was restless in the gate, prompted the pace on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, chased on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick and just missed the minor awards. NOAH'S HUMOR settled on the outside, was carried four wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail by the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and failed to rally. WILSONS STORM dropped well behind the field, raced two to three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. METAIRIE settled off the pace, swerved three wide early on the turn, dropped to the inside near the five-sixteenths pole and also failed to rally. ELLE UNION was rated just off the pace, chased four wide on the turn and came up empty. (Rail at 25 Feet)
