Footnotes

ALOT OF MERCY showed good speed and set the pace, controlled the tempo through the turn, responded well when asked in upper stretch and held under strong right hand urging. PERFECT EASTER was well placed on the inside, bobbled passing the half-mile pole, moved closer while inside on the far turn, moved out and was asked at the top of the stretch, chased the winner determinedly in the final furlong but was second best. I AM THE SHERIFF settled off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while able to secure the show. TACKY ANGEL smashed open the gate prior to the start, settled near the back of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. LYD RIVER broke through the gate prior to the start, settled just off the pace on the outside, raced three wide while urged some on the turn and weakened. EXCLUSIVE ALLIANCE stalked the leader on the outside, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped back a bit into the stretch and came up empty. PHANTOM STRIKE settled at the rear, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. (Rail at 25 Feet)
