HY HAND POKER stalked the pace on the outside, drew even on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, inched clear into the furlong marker and proved best under strong urging. JAN'S BIRD came out a bit at the start, tracked the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased under a drive into the final furlong was outfinished while clear for the place. SAFELY SPUN settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lacked room behind the pacesetter approaching the furlong marker, moved around that rival shortly thereafter and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. BUNKHOUSE set the pace on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened. MAS GOLD broke a bit slow, moved up to race just off the pace, was rated behind the pacesetter, drafted behind the leading duo on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. UNION WORKER settled towards the rear, was roused while off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. THREE J'S PATH settled at the rear while on the outside, went three wide on the turn, failed to respond when asked outside the quarter-pole and faltered.
