Footnotes

UPON REFLECTION had the rider stand up in the saddle briefly early but didn't lose any momentum, settled off the pace, was urged along on the turn, shifted three wide late on the bend, came under the whip in upper stretch, rallied on the outside and closed well to get up late. ALUMNI set the pace, vied near the inside on the turn, dueled with EDDIE'S BAND in the stretch, disposed of that opponent entering the final sixteenth but was caught near the wire. EDDIE'S BAND broke out and a bit slow then was corrected by the rider, moved up on the outside, tracked the pace, made a bid while three wide on the turn, dueled with ALUMNI into the final sixteenth and weakened while able to hold the show. PRIVATE PRAYER dropped back after the start, dropped well behind, raced towards the inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished with late energy but reached his best stride too late. ONE SURVIVOR chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and tired. ROSSINI'S REVENGE broke out then was corrected by the rider, settled while under some urging, went three wide on the turn and failed to respond.
