MINER'S LAMP forced the pace outside BROTHER BEAN until upper stretch and then while no match for that one was best of the rest. ARISTOCRAT settled off the rail and then passed beaten foes. REVERENTIAL out footed early, moved to the rail around the turn and then had no final kick. NO FAULT hit the side of the gate at the break, trailed to the drive and was not a factor. VIBANK showed speed to the drive and then stopped.
