MOMMIE WHIZ close up from early on, took over outside SHE'SA TOUGH TIGER in upper stretch and proved clearly best. SMARTY MARTY forwardly placed off the rail, was game for second. SHE'SA TOUGH TIGER angled in early while moving clear, remained clear to before the drive, got overtaken and saved the show. TRUE BREW between foes early, got out footed around the turn, angled out in the lane and made a late gain. GO HIDE AND WATCH between foes going to the turn, steadied when in tight, moved up for the drive, then had no final kick. BOBBY'S BELL trailed to the drive, then improved position. A. M. DUE unhurried early, came four wide around the second turn, then could make little impact. AUTUMN ROCK was outrun. PERFECT SWEETIE swerved in at the break, raced inside early and then dropped back.
