Footnotes

HOMERUN BERTI showed early speed then was eased back, moved to the outside, tracked while three wide on the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, drifted out under a left-handed whip near the furlong marker, ducked in when switched to a right-handed whip around the sixteenth-pole and proved best under a hand ride late. WHY NOT BE PERFECT settled on the inside while under some urging, was ridden along while saving ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished with good energy to garner the place. SOUTHERN REGION bumped lightly with a rival at the start, set the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch, was taken up a bit when the winner ducked in near the sixteenth-pole and weakened while able to get the show. BARRACUDA BAY settled towards the rear, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. EURO SILVER JET bumped lightly with a rival at the start, settled at the rear, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. LARRY'S VISION was urged along on the outside, raced five then four wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. MAJOR MARVEL was urged along in third position, raced four then three wide on the turn and also lacked the needed response. Following a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run, there was no change made to the order of finish. (Rail at 15 Feet)
