MAJESTIC HARBOR went four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, took the lead leaving the backstretch, inched clear midway through the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, responded well when put to a drive in upper stretch and held well under strong urging. MR. BOWLING was asked from the start then went to the front, set the pace on the inside, lost the lead leaving the backstretch, dropped back midway through the far turn, chased under the whip in upper stretch, raced behind MAJESTIC HARBOR while under urging in the final furlong and finished willingly for the place while unable to reach the winner. WASH PARK was rated just off the pace while off the inside, came under some urging early on the far turn, was asked for more passing the five-sixteenths pole, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. TAPTOWNE was rank while two then three wide on the first turn, moved up while fighting the rider with five furlongs to run, went three then four wide on the far turn, advanced on the outside, chased into the final furlong and weakened. CEASE was unhurried at the rear, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, moved out and bumped with IT HAPPENED AGAIN after straightening into the stretch and improved position. PRIME CUT went three then four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved up with five furlongs to run, advanced leaving the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. IT HAPPENED AGAIN went three to four wide on the first turn, settled near the back while on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn, bumped with CEASE outside the three-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. WORLDLY was reserved while eager and inside on the first turn, became rank near the five-eighths pole, dropped back in the process, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor.
