Footnotes

WILDRALLY saved ground on the first turn, was reserved at the back of the field, raced off the rail on the far turn, waited while between rivals in upper stretch, espied a seam between rivals near the furlong marker, rallied between those horses and closed fast to get up late. STRING KING raced four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, went two to three wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong and just missed. CLASSIC CASCADE raced three then two wide on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when set down in upper stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong and also just missed in a three-way photo. OLD BUSHMILL settled off the pace, went three to four wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive while behind a rival in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. SADIE'S SOLDIER went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced four to five wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. IDEFROMTHEBAYOU went straight to the lead, gave up the advantage on the first turn, was rated just behind CLASSIC CASCADE while on the inside, lugged out a bit leaving the backstretch and dropped back, saved ground into the stretch, was put to a drive while behind horses and also lacked the needed response.
