Footnotes

FIRE ALARM settled towards the rear, went two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed well to draw alongside his stablemate near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. TIZ MOE raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, gained the lead inside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. SKY ALERT bumped with GOOD NEW SHOES entering the first turn, raced three to four wide on that turn, settled off the pace, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, raced along the rail while under a drive in the stretch, hesitated near the sixteenth-pole and just got up for the show. BOLD FRONT lagged at the rear of the field, went three to four wide on the far turn, shifted five wide at the top of the stretch and improved position. M ONE set the pace through quick fractions, extended the lead on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and tired. SHORTBREAD was asked from the start, settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and also failed to rally. GOOD NEW SHOES bumped with SKY ALERT entering the first turn, raced five wide early on that turn then dropped to three wide, stalked the leader on the outside, chased two to three wide on the far turn and weakened. TETRADRACHM went two to three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased three to four wide on the far turn and faded.
