LINDAU moved up towards the inside, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied three then two wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and held under strong urging. VALLEY OF KINGS settled off the pace, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. SHAVE AND PAVE moved in while off the pace, was urged along while saving ground on the turn, came out slightly in upper stretch and got up for the show. CUTE TO BOOT set the pace, vied near the inside on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and weakened. SWOROVSKI was urged along towards the front, chased two then three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. LEESTOWN'S OMEGA was urged along on the outside, raced six wide on the turn and also lacked the needed response. ALL ABOUT INTEREST chased the pace on the outside, raced five wide on the turn and tired. MCDOWELL chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn and weakened. DISTURBINGBEHAVIOR chased the pace, raced four then three wide on the turn and capitulated. ELUSIVE HUMOR lost his footing at the start and broke about two lengths slow, raced well

back in the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. CHANCE IDE TAKE was fractious in the gate, dropped back while urged along and was no factor. CAMELOT DE CAT was taken up at the start, raced three to four wide on the turn and never reached contention. LIFE'S OTHER SIDE stumbled badly at the start, raced well back in the field, went seven wide on the turn and failed to respond.
