STAKES Allen LaCombe Memorial S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLD FILLIES. Free nomination by Tuesday, February 19. \$400 to enter; \$400 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$26,000 twice on the turf since November 2, allowed 2 lbs, \$18,000 twice on the turf since then, allowed 4 lbs, \$15,000 on the turf since then, allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The maximum field size for the Allen Lacombe Memorial Stakes will be determined by rail setting. Preference to horses with the highest lifetime earnings. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Tuesday, February 19, 2013, with 33 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and 70 Yards.) (Rail at 25 feet).

Footnotes

GATOR ZONE was taken in hand early, went three wide on the first turn, was rated in second position, tracked the pacesetter while three wide on the far turn, chased in upper stretch, gained a short lead passing the sixteenth-pole and gamely prevailed. TO MY VALENTINE (FR) went to the front, set the clear pace while a bit off the rail, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled back gamely when headed at the sixteenth-pole and just missed. OVERHEARD went four wide on the first turn, was unhurried near the back, raced four wide early on the far turn, shifted six wide near the five-sixteenths pole, advanced on the outside, held a good striking position into the final furlong but drifted out and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. MAGICAL MOON was taken under a strong hold while eager, raced two to three wide while rank on the first turn, continued rank while under a vigorous hold on the backstretch, bumped with EXOTIC MISCHIEF passing the three-eighths pole, dropped to the inside then advanced, moved out while chasing in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. SUNSET TIME went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, was pulled off heels at the furlong marker and failed to rally. EXOTIC MISCHIEF went three to four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, bumped with MAGICAL MOON near the three-eighths pole, raced three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. TONIGHT WE DANCE was rated towards the front, came up empty on the far turn and gave way. SMITTEN settled at the rear, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted five then six wide late on that bend and failed to threaten. CLOUDY IN SANDIEGO went four wide on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, went four wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. (Rail at 25 Feet)
