Footnotes

FIRST SON was well placed on the inside, came under intermittent urging while behind the pacesetter on the far turn, shifted off the rail at the quarter-pole, chased under the whip in upper stretch, took the lead entering the final furlong and edged clear under strong urging. BADTOTHEBONEBLAKE raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, disputed the pace on the inside of STARRYWALK, inched clear near the five-sixteenths pole, was set down in upper stretch, lost the advantage passing the furlong marker and was outfinished while well clear for the place. SOUTHOMO settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn and earned the show. SON HONEY went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. MOREMAMBO went five then four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, advanced three then four wide on the far turn but came up empty. Z MAN broke a bit slow, went four then three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under a ride with a half-mile to run, went two then three wide on the far turn and faded. STARRYWALK went four then three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped. DRAKE'S LASER resisted the tactics of the rider when taken back early, swerved out while very rank into the first turn, continued rank while six then five wide on that bend, dropped well behind and showed little. GOOSEY was fractious in the post parade, raced five wide early on the first turn, bore out to be eight wide midway through that bend, was very difficult to deal with for the rider, had the saddle slip in the process, dropped to six wide onto the backstretch, drifted well wide in the vicinity of the half-mile pole with the saddle still riding high, dropped back quickly and faltered.
